Communion

The Lord is here.

His Spirit is with us.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all creation;

in your love you made us for yourself.

When we turned away you did not reject us, but came to meet us in your Son.

You embraced us as your children and welcomed us to sit and eat with you.

In Jesus you shared our life that we might live in Him and He in us.

He made for all the perfect sacrifice for sin.

On the night He was betrayed, at supper with His disciples, He took bread, and gave you thanks; He broke it and gave it to them, saying: 'Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me'.

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine,

He gave you thanks, and said: 'Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins; do this in remembrance of me'.

As we proclaim His death and celebrate His rising in glory, send your Holy

Spirit, that this bread and this wine may be to us the body and blood of your dear Son.

As we eat and drink these holy gifts make us one in Jesus, our risen Lord.

With your whole Church throughout the world,

we offer you this sacrifice of praise, and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory,
Hosanna in the highest.**

Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup,
**we proclaim the Lord's death,
until He comes.**

Jesus, Lamb of God,
have mercy on us.

Jesus, bearer of our sins,
have mercy on us.

Jesus, redeemer of the world,
grant us peace.
