only Son, our Lord; for He is Your living
Word; through Him You have created all
things from the beginning, and formed us
in Your own image; through Him You have
freed us from the slavery of sin, giving
Him to be born as man, to die upon the
cross; You raised Him from the dead and
exalted Him to Your right hand on high;
through Him you have sent upon us Your
holy and life-giving Spirit, and made us a
people for Your own possession.

Therefore with angels and archangels,
and with all the company of heaven, we
proclaim Your great and glorious Name,
for ever praising You and singing:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,

Hosanna, Hosanna in the highest.
Holy, holy, holy Lord
God of power and might,
Blessed is He who comes in the Name
of the Lord.

Accept our praises, heavenly Father,
through Your Son, our Saviour Jesus the
Messiah; and as we follow His example and
obey His command, grant that by the power
of Your Spirit these gifts of bread and wine
may be to us His body and His blood.

For in the same night that He was betrayed,
He took bread; after giving You thanks,
Barukh atah Adonai Eloheinu,

*Melekh ha'olam ha'motzi lechem min
ha'aretz.*

Blessed are you, O Lord our God,
King of the universe, who brings forth
bread from the earth.
He broke it, gave it to His disciples, and said,
"Take, eat; this in My body which is given
for you. Do this in remembrance of Me.

Again, after supper He took the cup;
He gave you thanks, *Barukh atah Adonai
Eloheinu Melekh ha'olam, borei pri
ha'gefen.*

Blessed are you, O Lord our God, King of the
universe, who creates the fruit of the vine.

He gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of
you; for this is My blood of the New
Covenant, which is shed for you and for
many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as
often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
Great is the mystery of faith:

Messiah has died;

Messiah is risen;

Messiah will come again.

Lord Jesus come in glory.

Therefore, heavenly Father, with this bread
and this cup we do this in remembrance of
Him: we celebrate and proclaim His perfect
sacrifice made once for all upon the cross,
His resurrection from the dead, and His
ascension into heaven; and we look for
His coming in glory.

Accept through Him, our great High
Priest, this our sacrifice of thanks and
praise; and as we eat and drink these
holy gifts in the presence of Your divine
majesty, renew us by Your Spirit, inspire
us with Your love, and unite us in the body
of Your Son, Jesus the Messiah our Lord.
With Him, and in Him, and through Him,
by the power of the Holy Spirit, with all who
